

PAS New Horizon Award

Terms of Reference

The PAS New Horizon Award recognizes a pharmacist who has convocated in the past 5 years and has demonstrated impact and commitment to the pharmacy profession. The objective of this award is to encourage an interest in PAS Board activities, introduce the award recipient to his/her colleagues and provide an opportunity to attend the Pharmacy Association of Saskatchewan (PAS) annual conference.

The nomination should include:

- Evidence of impact and commitment to the pharmacy profession (post convocation) by advancing their practice, including but not limited to PAS involvement, service to their community and/or contributing to the development of student pharmacists either as a mentor or preceptor
1. The nominee must be a member of the Pharmacy Association of Saskatchewan (PAS) and a member in good standing of the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacy Professionals (SCPP).
 2. The nominee has convocated within the past 5 years and is practicing pharmacy in Saskatchewan.
 3. The recipient selection will be made by members of the PAS Awards Selection Committee and then presented to the PAS Board of Directors for approval.
 4. This award will be presented at the annual conference of the Pharmacy Association of Saskatchewan.
 5. The successful recipient will receive in the year the award is presented:
 - complimentary conference registration
 - Travel expenses for the conference *if required* (includes accommodation and mileage)
 - 1 additional PAS Awards Banquet ticket
 6. The PAS New Horizon Award recipient will be mentored by a PAS Board or Committee member at the conference.
 7. If there are no qualified candidates nominated in a given year, the award will not be granted.
 8. Only one award may be granted in a given year.
 9. The nominee cannot previously have received this award.
 10. Nominations are only valid for award consideration in the current year.
