"We continue to appreciate the Province's science-based Vaccine Rollout Delivery Plan," said Dawn Martin, Chief Executive Officer, Pharmacy Association of Saskatchewan (PAS). "We are proud to join other health care professionals in providing safe, timely access to COVID-19 vaccinations." Today's announcement that expands Phase 1 vaccine sequencing to those directly providing public vaccinations later this year, is an important commitment to ensure safe vaccination roll-out.

The Pharmacy sector recognizes that vaccine supply realities may complicate the delivery of COVID vaccines, however. "We are up for that challenge and we will continue to work tirelessly with the Province through every phase of the Plan," said Dawn Martin.

This builds on the expanding essential primary care role offered through the province's 400 pharmacies, such as the growing public acceptance of flu shots and other vaccines from pharmacies in recent years.
