

Fellowship Position in Health Services Research

The Opportunity

An exciting research fellowship position is available in the College of Pharmacy and Nutrition in the province of Saskatchewan, Canada.

The successful applicant will contribute to a range of health services research projects pertaining to the evaluation of pharmacy services. Opportunities are available in other areas of research depending on the candidate's interests and expertise. We welcome interested candidates from a variety of backgrounds, not just pharmacy. The projects will be clinically oriented, and patient centered.

The successful candidate will have ongoing engagement with health system stakeholders, clinicians, academics, research personnel, and patient partners. They will be involved with all aspects of research from drafting proposals, planning, obtaining ethical approvals, conducting research, data analyses, communicating findings, and publishing scientific manuscripts. The successful candidate will be mentored at each step to ensure their confidence and skills in achieving the objectives established by the research team. The position is expected to provide the candidate with excellent knowledge and skills derived from real world research experience in a collaborative research setting.

Job Requirements

The successful candidate will have demonstrated potential to excel in their field of research, exhibit excellent organizational ability, analytical and problem-solving skills, and an ability to assume leadership to meet research objectives. Effective written and verbal communication skills are necessary. Experience in mixed-methods research methods and a track record of publications in peer-reviewed journals are assets. Applicants should have knowledge of basic statistics and exhibit a strong desire for expanding their knowledge. Some travel may be required for data collection to Swift Current or Yorkton; expenses would be compensated.

Initially, this full-time position is offered for a one-year term, with the possibility of extension upon mutual agreement. It is open to applicants with a background in pharmacy or health sciences or research experience. At minimum, the candidate must possess a bachelor's degree. An honours degree, Master or PhD will be considered strong assets. The University of Saskatchewan hires on the basis of merit and is committed to employment equity. We encourage all qualified persons to apply. However, Canadians and permanent residents of Canada will be given priority.

Duration: Full time (1.0 FTE) for one-year, with the possibility of extension
